## **THE MASSAGE CAP**

Provides Comfort and Relaxation

PHILADELPHIA, PA—The Massage Cap is a specially designed personal massage unit configured in the shape of a helmet and designed to be placed over the head. The design intent is to provide consumers with a simple means of relieving minor headaches and tension caused by common stress, while also providing a relaxing and therapeutic scalp massage. It is similar in looks to a stationary hair dryer. Low level heating coils apply soothing therapy to the head and scalp at the same time it is massaging the scalp.

The degree of massage action can be controlled by a series of buttons on the exterior of the helmet and can be reached easily by the user. A remote panel is available as well and allows the user to adjust the settings without removing the Massage Cap.

The Massage Cap was invented by Kathleen Ann Crump of Philadelphia, PA. She said, “The Massage Cap sends a message to your body to relax and enjoy the therapeutic benefits it provides. It is gentle and touches the key pulse points of one’s temple, base of skull and back of the head and provides a noninvasive treatment that is a hands-free alternative to handheld electronic stimulators. And, it allows the user to read a book, watch TV or even taking a nap while it performs the vibrating massage.”
