THE TRAVELING TOILET

A portable toilet for use when traveling

BROOKLYN, NY—The Traveling Toilet is a specially designed portable urinal intended to provide travelers with a simple and sanitary means of going to the bathroom in the comfort and privacy of their own vehicle. It is the safest means of serving nature when the need to use the bathroom is eminent and one is on the road. The Traveling Toilet is leak and shatterproof and accommodates both the male and female anatomy. A sliding cover reveals the interior of the unit when pulled back and provides a comfortable seat for female users. A urinal with a tapered nozzle aids a male in eliminating urine.

The Traveling Toilet was invented by Melbourne and Elaine Meade of Brooklyn, NY. They said, “The Traveling Toilet allows travelers to use the lavatory in the privacy of their own vehicle whether on the road or on a roadside rest area where passing traffic is heavy and no toilets are available. It eliminates the need to search for rural rest areas with bathrooms (often a futile search) and can provide a sanitary alternative to use of public restrooms---often dirty and unsanitary. The Traveling Toilet is a private means providing a source of relief when the body calls for a need to eliminate either urine or bowels. It can be emptied at a place ‘down the road’ and leave the user with a complete feeling of relief when nature calls.”
