BALTIMORE, MD—Lightweight and comfortable, the Bionic Bracelet is a wireless electronic alert system that links one or more range-specific transmitter bracelets to one or more compact and portable receiver-bracelets. The bracelets are so designed that when a transmitter bracelet-worn by a child, an elderly person prone to wandering, or even a pet-goes beyond the specified, preset range, it raises an audible alarm and signals the receiver-bracelet-alerting the parent, caretaker, or pet-owner that their charge has strayed.

The Bionic Bracelet was invented by Anthony J. of Baltimore, MD.
