HUMBLE, TX—It is easy to transform the look of your car if you utilize Luz Rodante. The Luz Rodante is a vehicle accessory that lights up the wheels and rims when the brakes are applied. The LED lights install on rims and operate by a breaker box apparatus that can shut down the system if desired. The light emitting diodes also known as (LEDs) are offered in a variety of colors in order to appeal to individual tastes. The outer perimeter of the wheel well offers up to 4 large lights spaced evenly apart. Going inward, the outer rim ring features 4 more lights, medium in size and the inner rim ring is festooned with a circular collection of small lights. The result is a circular pattern of illumination whenever the brakes are pressed.

Luz Rodante was invented by Fernando A. Munoz Mayen of Humble, TX. He said, “Rolling Lights, also known as, “Luz Rodante” turn an ordinary automobile into a dazzling showpiece and provides auto enthusiasts with a striking and attractive means of improving the appearance of their vehicle.”
