## **THE S.O.R. (SELF OPERATING REGISTER) ...**

RESEDA, CA—The S.O.R. Self Operating Register is a specially designed register vent configured expressly to open and close in conjunction with the activation of the furnace or air conditioning unit. The design intent is to provide consumers with an energy efficient alternative to traditional register covers, thus reducing heating and cooling costs and saving the consumer money. The Self Operating Register will be available in a variety of sizes and shapes to accommodate different venting systems and household vents. The standard version is rectangular with both wall and floor mounted versions available.

The S.O. R. (Self Operating Register) was invented by Roman G. of Reseda, CA. He said, “These are fully functioning register covers that boast an integrated motor. The motor causes the cover to open when the furnace or AC is in operation and close when it is not in use. This prevents warm or cool air from escaping the vent and the room and helps keep one warm in the winter time and cool in the hot days of summer.”
