## **THE HANDY LIFT ...**

... is a convenient and easy-to-use lifting device

GLENDALE, AZ—The Handy Lift is a pneumatically operated jack that is specially designed to elevate large, heavy appliances off the floor and away from walls so that those areas can be more easily cleaned. The design intent is to provide a safer, more efficient means of accessing these areas.

The Handy Lift was invented by Elisa M. of Glendale, AZ. She said, “This invention would be useful in virtually any household. While cleaning, many people are confronted with the difficult task of having to clean or vacuum behind a large piece of furniture or piece of equipment such as a washing machine. This invention, however, would help alleviate these worries.

Basically, the Handy Lift is a device designed to lift heavy pieces of furniture or equipment up and away from walls allowing the user easy access to the floor underneath and behind the moved piece of furniture or equipment. The Handy Lift would be incredibly easy to use and would require minimal effort on the part of the user. They would only need to simply slide the device underneath the piece of furniture to be moved, use the foot pedal to raise the item, and pull it away from the wall. By doing this, users can maintain a clean and fresh household even behind bulky furniture and equipment.”
