PHOENIX, AZ—The Handy Cart is a sturdy, wheeled cart configured expressly to transport trash bags collected from trash cans employed at retail and business establishments, to the venue's dumpster or trash compactor. The design intent is to provide the owners and operators of these establishments a user friendly, sanitary and designated method of emptying large trash cans.

The Handy Cart, Rose Cart, Trash Cart was invented by Julie F. and Carmen C. of Phoenix, AZ. They said, "This invention would be beneficial to most establishments that empty their own trash. Basically, the Handy Cart would be a wheeled cart designed for collecting large bags of trash with ease. The design allows users to simply slide the front panel of Handy Cart down allowing easy access to the interior of the cart meaning users would no longer have to lift heavy trash bags over the cart sides.

Also, the Handy Cart would feature a number of smaller receptacles for tools, extra bags, etc. Finally, the Handy Cart would also feature an adjustable grip rail allowing for easy use by virtually anyone in the establishment."
