Unlike other, fixed-mount, rigid towing assemblies, the Slam Hitch will not dramatically reduce the vertical clearance of the truck. Where other towing assemblies effectively defeat the purpose of a raised-suspension truck, the Slam Hitch will perform as a strong, dependable, heavy-duty towing package-yet retract when the towing job is completed, “stowing itself”, in effect, neatly to the underside of the frame.
